

## Alternative Love Songs

### 1. Cure &dash; Pictures of You, from the medium Disintegration (1989)

The unequalled sadness of Robert Smith anchored by complex synth and bass riffs, consistent drum patters and a country line impart the complain of the consequence when realizing that the choice was wrong.

### 2. Depeche Mode &dash; I Feel You, from the medium Songs of Faith and Devotion (1993)

&ldquo;I feel you, your heart it sings, I feel you, the joy it brings, where heaven waits, those metallic gates and back again you take me to and advance me finished oblivion.&rdquo;

Dominant synth, controversial bluesy bass chords, atmospheric drums, grunge-influenced emotion and superior lyrics comprise one of the best deciding love songs of the 90s.

### 3. Garbage &dash; You Look So Fine, from the medium Version 2.0 (1999)

&ldquo;You look so fine, I want to break your heart and provide you mine, you&rsquo;re taking me over, it&rsquo;s so insane, you&rsquo;ve got me tethered and chained, I hear your name and I&rsquo;m dropping over.&rdquo;

Purely fresh line spoken finished a humid vocalise anchored in obscure bass riffs, patch reflecting mature pop scene.

### 4. Lucky Jim &dash; The Honeymooners, from the medium Our Troubles End Tonight (2007)

&ldquo;Oh lover, still your tongue, you&rsquo;re the king of every you see, the unmade bottom you lie upon, this fantastic likeness of me, my body be your focus, your have be my joy, for everything&rsquo;s decided in the shine of an eye.&rdquo;

Atmospheric ballad, with consistent bass chords anchored to a slightly military drum pattern, and a deeply personal performance reflecting the psyche of a sorrowful love affair.

### 5. Oasis &dash; Wonderwall, from the medium (What&rsquo;s the Story) Morning Glory? (1995)

&ldquo;The fire in your heart is out, I&rsquo;m trusty you&rsquo;ve heard it every before, but you never really had a doubt, I don&rsquo;t believe that anybody feels the artefact I do most you now.&rdquo;

The idiosyncratic vocalise of Liam Gallagher carries the listener absent for the 4:18 minutes that one of the most memorable tunes in the history of deciding sway lasts.

### 6. Placebo &dash; Crawl, from the medium Without You I&rsquo;m Nothing (1998)

&ldquo;It takes the discompose away, but could not attain you stay, it&rsquo;s artefact too broke to fix, no glue, no bag of tricks, place me down, the lie module unfurl, place me downbound to crawl.&rdquo;

Being the landmark of glam sway of the &lsquo;90s and the toughest of English pupil guitar-glam bands, Placebo feature &ldquo;The Crawl&rdquo;, a hymn of piano gloom that gives Brian Molko an edge and makes the assemble one of the best deciding groups of the 90s.

### 7. Portishead &dash; Roads, from the medium Dummy (1994)

&ldquo;Oh, can&rsquo;t anybody see, we&rsquo;ve got a war to fight, never found our way, regardless of what they

say.&rdquo;

The complain for an ill-fated relation approached with a suffering, violently theatrical set and the unequalled vocals of Beth Gibbons.

8. Radiohead &ndash; Creep, from the medium Pablo Honey (1993)

&ldquo;I don&rsquo;t care if it hurts, I wanna have control, I want a amend body, I want a amend soul, I want you to notice, when I&rsquo;m not around, you&rsquo;re so f\*\*n&rsquo; special, I desire I was special.&rdquo;

The grievance for lacking self-confidence spoken with a solid tune, the &ldquo;Creep&rdquo; gave rise to Radiohead making them one of the most important and quickly rising deciding bands in the history of rock. Moving from the deciding to the mainstream, Radiohead have spread the seeds of glory.

9. Skunk Anansie &ndash; Infidelity (Only You), from the medium Stoosh (1997)

&ldquo;In my face there&rsquo;s no more joy, I&rsquo;m every I should be, cracked infidelity is every you are to me.&rdquo;

Subtle, moody, and melodic countenance of intense emotion, anger, and complain anchored with the outrageous tenderness of Skin&rsquo;s vocalise and a mature metal sound, breeding elements of funk.
